

Town Manager Update Report September 25, 2015

Chief's Position

The Fire and Rescue Chief position will post today on the Town Website, Jobs in Maine, and the Maine Municipal Association website. Monday the position will post to the Maine Fire Chief's Association, International Fire Chief's Association, and the Sun Journal. The cost of advertising to the Portland Press Herald would be approximately \$800. Therefore, we're holding that option for the moment.

Chief Sacco is officially on vacation until October 2nd, with his Deputies providing coverage. Interim Chief Levasseur will take command on October 2nd at 4 pm.

Town Owned Property - 328B Sabbathday Road

A bill of sale for the vandalized mobile home at this location has been issued in exchange for full removal of the unit. The bill of sale stipulates removal by 10/16/15.

Outlet Bridge Road

The Outlet Road will re-open at the end of the day today.

Town Hall Windows

The second half of the Town Hall first floor windows were installed this week. Following the installation, all first floor window frames were painted by the contractor.

Public Works Crew
