Below are a few highlights from this past week in review:

- The Fire and Rescue advisory group met this past Wednesday to review resumes. Candidates for interview were selected and first round interviews have been scheduled for early December. We have a very good pool of candidates to work with.
- We have received notice from Superior Court regarding the Sacco Bench Trial. The Bench Trial has been scheduled to begin on December 2nd at 8:30 am in Courtroom 9. It is scheduled to continue through December 3rd. The Judge is still considering the summary motion before her.
- The Tax Acquired Property located at 328b Sabbathday Road has gone out to bid in accordance with the board's instructions and our foreclosure ordinance. The bid documents are accessible through the Town's website. They have been reviewed by the Town attorney.
- I attended last night's public safety meeting and the committee is working on a top ten list for me.
- Special Town Meeting and CIP preparations are moving forward according to schedule.
- Ted Shane and I attended DOT workshop on winter road maintenance. We came back with a few specific items to implement that we will be sharing with you.
