

Town Manager Update Report December 4, 2015

Below are a few highlights from this past week in review:

The Fire and Rescue Chief Advisory Group are scheduled to conclude first round interviews Monday, December 7th. The interview process continues to proceed smoothly.

The Deputy Treasurer position closes on December 18th. We continue to receive applications.

Thursday concluded the two-day bench trial of the Sacco Case. The “trial of the facts” was heard by Federal Superior Court Judge Nancy Mills. I was present at the defendant’s table for the entire trial. At the conclusion of the trial, Judge Mills requested post trial briefs from the attorneys. After both sides have had an opportunity to submit comments on the post-trial briefs, Judge will be able to move forward with a decision. I do not expect to see a decision until late spring or early summer.

Below is a quote from this morning’s Sun Journal article: “Town selectmen had voted 3-2 in executive session on Nov. 4, 2013, to reduce Sacco’s full-time job to 24 hours per week and to rescind her benefits.” I plan to contact the Sun Journal regarding the inaccuracy of the article.
