Below are a few highlights from the business of this past week:

The Public Works crew has been on Meadow Road, preparing for paving, and graveling-in the driveways and shoulders on Mayall, Dougherty, and North Pownal Roads. Our Public Works crew has accomplished a lot this summer – they’ve worked hard. While I have not had a chance to see it myself, I also understand that we’ve taken delivery of the new Kubota mower. We’re still waiting to take delivery on the Radar Speed Sign, which I expect any day.

The week of September 19th will be busy for the Selectmen. The regular Selectmen’s meeting is shaping up to be interesting and is expected to include:
