- Town of New Gloucester population  
At the time of the most recent United States Census Survey, the number of people in New Gloucester, ME was 5,542 back in 2010 and 4,804 back in 2000. The United States Census Survey is taken every 10 years.
- John brought up the “Consumer Fireworks Ordinance” that was voted down at the Town Meeting back on May 04, 2015.
- At the New Gloucester Board of Selectmen meeting on Monday, June 01, 2015, Mr. Phil Vampatella talked about motor vehicles & motorcycles speeding along Intervale Road near his home which is located near Memorial Elementary School. He would like something to be done to slow the vehicles down.
- The Public Safety Committee talked about the issue of vehicles going to fast near Memorial School. Perhaps temporary speed bumps could be installed or speed signs.
- No “Parking Signs” have been requested by the head custodian at Memorial School. Two signs should be placed in front of Memorial side of the road.
