

DISBURSEMENT WARRANT ORDINANCE
Town of New Gloucester

Adopted: January 12, 2004

THE TOWN OF NEW GLOUCESTER, acting by and through a town meeting hereby ordains the following Disbursement Warrant Ordinance:

Section 1. Purpose.

The purpose of this ordinance is to provide an alternative to the statutory procedure for approval of warrants authorizing the treasurer to disburse money.

Section 2. Authority.

This ordinance is enacted pursuant to 30-A M.R.S.A. Sec. 3001 (municipal home rule) and 5603 (2) (A).

Section 3. Procedure for Approval.

The treasurer may disburse money only on the authority of a warrant drawn for the purpose, either (a) affirmatively voted and signed by a majority of the municipal officers (selectmen) at a duly called public meeting, (b) seen and signed by a majority of them acting individually and separately, or (c) signed as otherwise provided by law for the disbursement of employees' wages and benefits and payment of municipal education costs.
