

**MINUTES FOR SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
Town of New Gloucester
January 14, 2013**

ARTICLE 1. To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

No other nominations were made.
Motion to close nominations: Stephen Hathorne
Seconded by: Joshua McHenry
Those in favor of closing nominations: All
Opposed: None
Nomination of Donald Libby carried.
3 votes were cast for Donald Libby.

- **Convey an easement to the New Gloucester Water District and to authorize the Town Manager to execute the same.**
